There are currently over 200 scholarships available for those in pursuit of an Associate degree, and over 250 scholarships available for those in pursuit of a Bachelor degree or transfer scholarships, and even scholarships for those pursuing a graduate degree. Many of the scholarships can be applied for using one generic application found on www.PTK.org under the scholarships tab.

Another valuable resource for scholarships and information is www.CollegeFish.org. CollegeFish can be linked to your PTK profile and will automatically populate much of your information. This website is extremely helpful in finding scholarships outside of what is offered from PTK, as well as it will put you in touch with many other colleges and inform of any opportunities in your area!
